Exodus 12-13:17

Passover: Holiday Celebrating God's Protection of Israel
Feast of Unleavened Bread: One Week Celebrating Exodus

Five Parts to Passover:

- 1) Barbecue, 2) Blood, 3) Bread, 4) Rest, 5) Remembering

Five Thoughts on Remembering/Celebration:

- 1) We remember better together.
 - More perspective
 - More thanksgiving
- 2) We can "remember" things we didn't personally experience.
- 3) We remember best in rest.
- 4) We remember best with rituals.
- 5) We remember the past to get perspective in the present.

When Jesus Changed Passover (Luke 22:7-20)

LIFE GROUP LESSON, MARCH 17-23

1. Finish the following statements:
This is how God has used this group in my life over the last 10 weeks...

2. What have been your most meaningful family traditions?
3. Read Exodus 12:1-14. Looking back at this week's teaching, was there anything that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you? Anything you hoped we could talk about?
4. Exodus 12:12 tells us the Passover was a judgment against all the gods of Egypt. In light of this, how do you think God feels about the idols in our own lives?
5. Read John 1:29 and Isaiah 53:4-6. Which aspects of the Passover story have the strongest parallels in Jesus' substitutionary atonement (his death on the cross for our sins)?
6. What are some similarities between Passover and our observance of Communion? How can understanding Passover make communion more meaningful to us?
7. Read Deuteronomy 7:7 and Ephesians 2:8. Was Israel saved from God's judgment because of their goodness? ...Or the blood of the Passover lamb? What does this tell us about the nature of God's salvation?
8. Read Revelation 5:11-14. In light of this lesson on the Passover Lamb, how does this passage impact your faith?
